

RESOLUTION NO. 2023 -04

A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE CITY OF LAFAYETTE HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIPS PROGRAM AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN (HOME-ARP) ALLOCATION PLAN

WHEREAS, Section 3205 of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (P.L. 117-2) (ARP) provides for HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME-ARP) funding under the HOME statute of Title II of the National Affordable Housing Act (42 U.S.C. 12721 et seq.) to address the need for housing and supportive services for persons experiencing or at risk of homelessness and other vulnerable populations at greatest risk of housing instability; and

WHEREAS, HOME-ARP program requirements are established in the Housing and Urban Development Notice CPD-21-10: Requirements for the Use of Funds in the HOME-ARP Program and the HOME program regulations at 24 CFR 92; and

WHEREAS, WHEREAS, the City of Lafayette is the lead agency for the Lafayette Housing Consortium, representing the Cities of Lafayette and West Lafayette, the Town of Battle Ground and the unincorporated areas of Tippecanoe County; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lafayette received an allocation of HOME-ARP funding in the amount of \$2,967,029; and

WHEREAS, the Lafayette Housing Authority, acting as the Federal Grant Administrator for the City of Lafayette has prepared an allocation plan for expending HOME-ARP funds within the Lafayette Housing Consortium's jurisdiction, which is summarized as follows:

Supportive Services	\$521,000.00
Development of Affordable Rental Housing	\$2,000,000.00
Administration and Planning	\$445,054.00
Total HOME-ARP Allocation	\$2,967,029.00

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAFAYETTE approves the HOME-ARP Allocation Plan and the application for this federal assistance, including all understandings and assurances contained therein; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, the Mayor of the City of Lafayette be designated and authorized to sign and submit such applications, to enter into such agreements as are appropriate to implement said programs, to act in connection with the applications, and to provide such additional information as may be required.
