City of Lafayette Breaks Ground on Loeb Stadium Renovations

LAFAYETTE, INDIANA – August 27, 2019 – Renovations on the Historic Loeb Stadium commenced today with a groundbreaking ceremony at the site in Columbian Park. Construction on the new \$19.8 million stadium will begin in the following days. Changes include a new press box, multiple concession stands and bathrooms, stadium seats, a terrace level with hospitality suites, and turf. The re-oriented entrance to Loeb Stadium will face Main Street and will be used for a variety of entertainment including baseball games, soccer games, football games, concerts and private events.

Indianapolis based Engineering Firm American Structurepoint handled the design and development of the new facility. JR Kelly Co. is the general contractor on the project and Kettelhut Construction Inc. is providing project management services for the new construction.

“This project offers the opportunity to enhance Lafayette’s family entertainment options in an incredibly flexible way. We look forward to creating this feature-rich, multi-use stadium that will be a handsome gateway for residents and visitors alike,” shared Mayor Tony Roswarski.

Infrastructure work surrounding the stadium has begun; construction is set to conclude in the fall of 2020.
