### **Lafayette City Hall Will Resume Full Operations Starting October 5**

Utility Billing Office will only be open to the public for applications.

**LAFAYETTE, INDIANA – October 2, 2020** – Lafayette City Hall will continue with full operations now including normal business hours for the Utility Billing Office effective Monday, October 5, 2020. Hours will be from 8:00 am to 4:30 pm daily, Monday through Friday.

If you need to visit City Hall, we welcome you with the following guidelines:

- Guests entering City Hall will be limited to those that need to conduct business.
- Guests can enter City Hall at our South Entrance on South Street **and now** the North Entrance on Columbia Street.
- Guests are required to wear a facemask and keep six-feet apart for social distancing during their visit to City Hall per the Governor's orders. Guests showing any signs of illness will be asked to leave.
- The Utility Billing Office will be open to the public for applications for service. Please continue to make payments at the drop-box, pay-by-phone, by mail, or online. A new website has been created for more options electronically.
- We want to encourage all citizens to continue the use of electronic methods whenever possible to conduct City business.
