



Parking expansion efforts focus on safty, quality of life for downtown residents and near downtown neighborhoods

Eariler this year, the Lafayette Parking Commission and Lafayette City Council officially adopted a Resolution within the existing Lafayette Parking Ordinance to grant full parking expansion authority to the Lafayette Parking Operations Department. The parking expansion extends north to Union Street and south to Fountain Street, Romig and Hitt streets, to the west from 2nd Street and east up to 18th Street and back down through Perrin Avenue.


Please be aware of the **Top 5 most common violations within the expansion** neighborhoods:

- 1) Parking against the flow of traffic
- 2) Parking too close to a corner
- 3) Abandoned vehicles, especially those parked in alleys, blocking right of ways, and/or not properly licensed
- 4) Parking on a curb or sidewalk
- 5) Vehicles blocking a fire hydrant

All of the above violations are considered major safety hazards that put others in danger. For a complete list of violations and specific parking details please refer to the complete **Lafayette Parking Ordinance at lafayette.in.gov**.

The goal of the parking expansion is to improve the overall quality of life and traffic safety in these areas, as well as further coordinate city departments with code and ordinance enforcements. By giving expansion authority to the Parking Operations Department, the city is able to help alleviate Lafayette Police Department involvement, allowing them to focus more efforts towards crime prevention and community protection.
