The Bicentennial Gateway Sculptures are one in a series of bicentennial themed public art installations funded in part by the Place Based Investment Fund Grant through the Office of Community and Rural Affairs and Indiana State Tourism Development.

Located in Lafayette's arts and culture districts, the project was led by the Lafayette Economic Development Department, project manager Margy Deverall, the County's Bicentennial Commission, and supported by business owners, arts organizations, city and county government, Greater Lafayette Commerce, the Community Foundation of Greater Lafayette and downtown volunteer organizations.
