



# HAPPY FOURTH OF JULY

**FOR YOUR SAFETY and SECURITY**, we ask that you refrain from using, handling or lighting fireworks, sparklers, firecrackers or any type of incendiary fireworks during this celebration. **We especially request that you do not bring pets to this concert as they do not tolerate cannon fire or fireworks well.** We also ask that you refrain from any solicitation, fighting or lewd behavior.

## THE POSSESSION AND USE OF ALCOHOL IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED

**RESTROOMS:** are located in the Depot parking lot, just north of the stage area and on the west end of the Pedestrian Bridge.

**FIRST AID and EMERGENCY:** Emergency staff and police officers are available throughout the evening.

**CONCESSIONS:** Kona Ice, The Guac Box, Famous Franks, RTB Chefs, Boiler Garden, Sheepdog Coffee Company and Nanny Boo Kettle Corn will be located just north of the Depot along 2nd Street.

**SMOKING: Smoking is prohibited at this event.**

Stars & Stripes operates under a color coded festival warning system. A threat consists of weather, potential weather, or any emergency situation requiring the implementation of our contingency plan. A current color code will be displayed at the broadcast center, at all concession booths, and at the Mobile Operations Center.

**GREEN:** No threats. Normal Operation.

**YELLOW:** Possible Threats.

- Severe storms within 100 miles of the event and tracking toward the Lafayette/West Lafayette area.

- A Severe Thunderstorm or Tornado Watch issued by the National Weather Service for Tiptecanoe County.

**ORANGE:** Likely Threats

- Severe storms within 50 miles of the event and tracking toward the Lafayette/West Lafayette area.

- Any information received from emergency agencies of a possible civil disturbance.

**RED:** Imminent Threat

- Severe Storms within 20 miles of the event and tracking toward downtown Lafayette.

- Any public disturbance (fire, shots fired, chemical spills, etc.)
