#### **Demolition of an Historic Structure Memo**

To: Lafayette Board of Public Works and Safety

Re: 625 Columbia Street – Partial Demolition of Structure

Date: December 28, 2020

The City of Lafayette as property owner of 625 Columbia Street has applied for an improvement location permit to demolish a significant portion of the building to accommodate the new Public Safety Building and Parking Garage on that site. The north façade of the historic building (facing Columbia Street) will be dismantled, salvaged, stored off site during construction and then reconstructed for reuse as part of the Public Safety Building and Parking Garage project or for reuse off-site at a different location to be determined. Because the property is within the Upper Main National Historic District, this demolition request has been reviewed by Dann Keiser, Lafayette Historic Preservation Officer, who determined that demolition of the house would be a loss of an historic resource of the City of Lafayette. Consequently, Mr. Keiser recommends that the 60-day waiting period be maintained. The City of Lafayette agrees with Mr. Keiser's determination.
