**AN AMENDMENT TO RESOLUTION 2012-01
A RESOLUTION OF THE HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION OF
THE CITY OF LAFAYETTE, INDIANA
GRANTING COMMISSION STAFF AUTHORIZATION POWERS**

Whereas, Ordinance 2010-11, section 12.01.080 permits the Historic Preservation Commission of the City of Lafayette, Indiana (“Commission”) to authorize the staff of the Commission, on behalf of the Commission, to grant or deny an application for a Certificate of Appropriateness via an adopted resolution;

Whereas, on July 30, 2012, the Commission adopted Resolution 2012-01 which granted Commission staff certain authorization powers;

Whereas, the City of Lafayette is adopting an ordinance to allow Parklets and Streeteries on City streets;

Whereas, it is in the best interest of the Commission and the public to grant authorization to Commission staff to review of Parklets and Streeteries applications;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Historic Preservation Commission of the City of Lafayette, Indiana hereby amends Resolution 2012-01 to allow Commission staff to review and approve Certificates of Appropriateness for Parklets and Streeteries in Local Historic District. As amended, Commission Staff Authorization Powers shall be as set forth on the attached Exhibit “A”.

EXHIBIT A

COMMISSION STAFF AUTHORIZATION POWERS

In an effort to expedite the approval of certain Certificates of Appropriateness (COAs) the Lafayette Historic Preservation Commission grants Commission Staff the following authorization powers:

- Authorization to approve Parklets and Streateries.
- Authorization to approve of signs that comply with guidelines set forth in the City of Lafayette Historic Preservation Commission Signage Design Guidelines Adopted 30 April 2012.
- Authorization to approve the installation of storm windows.
- Authorization to approve the installation of re-skinning of canvas awnings and canopies of a simple design.
- Authorization to approve the installation of historically appropriate handrails.
- Authorization for the temporary removal of historic building components for the purpose of repair.
- Authorization to approve historically appropriate replacement roof sheathing when there are no structural changes.
- Authorization to approve the removal of chimneys that are only visible from the rear of a structure or marginally visible from the street associated with the structure's primary façade.
- Authorization to approve the installation of stained or leaded glass windows.
- Authorization to approve the installation of historically appropriate shutters.
- Authorization to approve the removal of a non-original addition or alteration to a structure.
- Authorization to approve the extension of an approved COA for up to one additional year if the project scope has not changed.
