1. Deliver to Owner Three (3) counterparts of the Agreement, fully executed by Contractor.
2. Deliver with the executed Agreement the Contract security [*e.g., performance and payment bonds*] and insurance documentation as specified in the Instructions to Bidders and General Conditions, Articles 2 and 6.
3. Other conditions precedent:
 - a. Enroll in and verify the work eligibility status of all its newly hired employees through the E-Verify Program. Submit completed E-Verify Affidavit form to Owner.
 - b. Submit E-Verify case verification numbers for each individual required to be verified under IC 22-5-1.7 that will be working on this project.
 - c. Provide Certificate of Insurance including Owner and Engineer as additional insured on a primary non-contributory basis.

Failure to comply with these conditions within the time specified will entitle Owner to consider you in default, annul this Notice of Award, and declare your Bid security forfeited.

Within ten days after you comply with the above conditions, Owner will return to you one fully executed counterpart of the Agreement, together with any additional copies of the Contract Documents as indicated in Paragraph 2.02 of the General Conditions.
