Public Relations and Education Committee- No report

District Committee

A petition to expand the existing Local Centennial/Trinity Historic District to include **600 & 608 Ferry St.** (St. John's Church and Rectory) was submitted by The Reverend Dr. Bradley Pace, Rector on behalf of the St. John's Vestry. John Collier presented on behalf of the petitioner and stated that the church is a Gothic Revival style built about 1851-1858 and rated outstanding. The Rectory is a Greek Revival built in the 1840s and retains its historic value. Historic Preservation Officer, Dann Keiser, confirmed that both properties warrant inclusion into the local district. Kevin Klinker made a motion to approve the petition, Julie Ginn seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
