

ORDINANCE 2022-17

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 1.02 OF THE
LAFAYETTE MUNICIPAL CODE
PERTAINING TO ORDINANCE VIOLATION BUREAU**

WHEREAS, Ordinance 97-36, codified as 1.02.01 et seq. of the Lafayette Municipal Code created an Ordinance Violations Bureau; and

WHEREAS, Section 1.02.020 designates certain officers and employees of the City as authorized to issue uniform tickets for Ordinance Violations; and

WHEREAS, subsequent to the establishment of the Ordinance Violation Bureau the City created a position known as the “Downtown Security Officer”; and

WHEREAS, the Downtown Security Officer is familiar with City ordinances that are enforced through Ordinance Violation Bureau and enforcement of City ordinances can be enhanced by adding the Downtown Security Officer as a City employee authorized to issue uniform tickets for Ordinance Violations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDINANCE, by the Common Council of the City of Lafayette, Indiana as follows:

1. That Section 1.02.020(A) shall be amended to add a new subsection 8 as follows:

1.02.020 – Members.

A.8. Downtown Security Officer.

2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage and publication as required by law.
