The obligation and scope of services of HWC under this amendment shall be as follows:

Section 401/404 Permits (Services to be completed by subconsultant EMCS, Inc.)

Wetlands delineated are considered Water of the State (WOS). Will submit the Waters Report to the US Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) along with the Jurisdictional Determination (JD). Will fill out isolated wetland worksheets for each of the impacted wetlands. Will submit the approved JD, isolated wetland worksheets, and Waters Report to IDEM requesting a WOS determination and to concur all wetlands are Class I and exempt from requiring permits.

HWC shall be reimbursed as compensation for such professional services described above as follows:

\$7,000 Lump Sum

It is further mutually agreed by the CLIENT and HWC that all other provisions of the original agreement shall remain unchanged.
