Call To Order

Andrew Muffett, President, noted that a quorum was present and opened the meeting of the Lafayette Parking Commission at 11:00 a.m.

Election of Officers

Current officers: Andrew Muffett, President

Ken McCammon, Vice President

Cindy Murray, Secretary

All the existing officers agreed to continue in their existing roles. Cindy Murray moved to approve the slate of officers as listed. Ken McCammon seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Approve Meeting Minutes

Ken McCammon moved to approve the October 17, 2022 Parking Commission meeting minutes as submitted.

Cindy Murray seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

New Business

Approval of City of Lafayette Parking Garages Monthly Pass Options

Billy Emerson of Parking Operations reported that the City's garage parking rates had not been updated in about 10 years. In anticipation of the new parking garage that is currently under construction, the proposed rates will be implemented about the time that the new parking garage opens in April. John Withers, Parking Operations Manager, and Billy Emerson have discussed the proposed rates with Dennis Carson and the Mayor. The changes to the monthly rates will be as follows:

- Downtown Resident rate increases \$5/month from \$40 to \$45.
- Unreserved (hunt and find space option) rate increases \$7/month from \$63 to \$70.
- Reserved rate increases \$5/month from \$95 to \$100.
- Reserved space with a sign monthly rate remains the same at \$125.

- Parking operations will offer a new dual garage parking rate (where a person can park in either garage) at the following rates:
 - Downtown Resident rate of \$55/month
 - Unreserved rate of \$80/month

Ken McCammon moved to approve the changes in the monthly garage rates. Frank Donaldson seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Parking Operations –

- Presented the Parking Commission with a printed breakdown of citations since the last meeting. A citation was implemented to track the boot fee midway through the year.

Director's Report-Introduced Economic Development intern, Naja Barnes.

Public Comment-There were no additional comments from the public.

Adjournment

There being no further business to come before the Commission, the meeting of the Lafayette Parking Commission was adjourned at 11:15pm.
