City of Lafayette Hosts Public Meeting and Workshop Public Invited to Help Shape Five Points Redevelopment Plan

LAFAYETTE, INDIANA – September 21, 2017 – The City of Lafayette Economic Development Department welcomes the public to attend a meeting to share input on improving the Five Points area in the heart of the city. The meeting will be held on **Thursday, September 28, 6:00-7:30pm at Jenks Rest in Columbian Park.**

We are interested in the potential to revitalize the Five Points intersection, Main Street from Five Points to Columbian Park, and the edge of neighborhoods next to this corridor. Adjoining neighborhoods include Columbian Park, Perrin, St. Mary's, Valley Center, Presidents Triangle and South Oakland. A team of consultants is working with stakeholders and the public to consider commercial, residential, and public opportunities, and is gathering data regarding history, vehicle, bicycle and pedestrian traffic, existing uses, development potential, ownership patterns, and architectural assets.

Refreshments will be served and families are welcome. Jenks Rest is located in Columbian Park on Scott Street and overlooks the lagoon. Parking is available next to the building. Your input is critical to the success of the study and integral to future plans for the Five Points intersection – please plan on attending.
