## Use or Discharge of Consumer Fireworks

LAFAYETTE, IN – 5/30/2020 –

Retailers are gearing up for the July 4<sup>th</sup> holiday by beginning to offer for sale consumer fireworks.

The Lafayette Fire Department would like to remind all residents that the use or discharge of consumer fireworks is prohibited by Chapter 11.17 of the Lafayette City Municipal Ordinance except for the following dates and times:

- June 29, 30, July 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9  
5pm-2 hours after sunset
- July 4  
10 am-midnight
- December 31  
10 am-1 am on January 1

Individuals found to be violating this ordinance are subject to seizure and disposition of the fireworks and fined up to two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00).
