

To obtain a permit the applicant must: (1) submit a completed Dumpster Permit Application; (2) submit a site plan showing the location and dimensions of the dumpster; and (3) submit a Certificate of Liability Insurance listing the City of Lafayette as an additional insured (the insurance must include a hold harmless agreement addendum, agreeing to hold the City of Lafayette harmless from any and all liability arising from the placement of the dumpster on the street).

Guidelines for Dumpster Placement:

1. State and Local Laws pertaining to dumpsters must be followed.
2. Dumpster must be parked in a designated parking lane.
3. Dumpster cannot be placed in violation of parking regulations, City Ordinance 72.06.
4. If a dumpster has a door at one end, the door must be placed facing traffic.
5. Reflective tape, signs, or cones need to be placed warning drivers of the hazard. If needed, items can be placed upon the dumpster.
6. Dumpster cannot be placed for more than 5 days without prior approval, City Ordinance 72.10.
7. When the dumpster is removed, the area needs to be clear of debris.
8. Dumpsters cannot be placed in any manner that would cause a traffic hazard.
9. If a dumpster is found in violation of any guidelines, the dumpster will be removed by order of the City Engineer.
10. Upon removal, the condition of the street where the dumpster was placed must be in the same condition as before it was placed – a pre and post inspection will be conducted to verify condition of the street.
